CILS publishes reviews of current scholarly books, including monographs and edited volumes. These reviews comprise an important service to the academic community as a way to support peer contributions and situate new work within the literature and relevant conversations. Both solicited and unsolicited reviews are welcome, please contact the <u>Book Review Editor</u> for further information and to submit completed reviews

Submissions will be reviewed in-house and may be subject to revisions and/or corrections as determined by the editors. The final decision on whether or not a book review will be published remains with the Book Review Editor and editors of the journal. All accepted reviews will be published online. Selected reviews will also be republished in print issues as space allows.

Guidelines for Book Reviews:

- Book reviews (maximum 5 pages in length, following APA 7th edition guidelines) should provide an overview of the contents of the work as well as a well-argued judgment regarding its place in the field and its likely importance to the readers of journal. Mere content summaries are undesirable;
- Reviews of two or more related works are encouraged (maximum 12 pages in length, following APA 7th edition guidelines);
- References can be used, including up to, so as to locate the book reviewed within the existing literature as it relates to material reviewed.
- Book reviews should indicate the following: title, author, location and name of publisher, date of publication, number of pages, ISBN(s), hbk/pbk edition price(s). The following format is preferred: Title of the book
