The Clinical Neuropsychologist online-only supplement

The online supplement on international neuropsychological practice publishes high quality research that is of particular interest to discrete subsets of our readers outside of North America. Articles in this supplement typically contain normative data and validation findings for major neuropsychological instruments, with discrete applicability to specific non-North American regions of the world.

Normative studies must demonstrate (a) that the instrument has been validated and is ready for clinical use and (b) that the normative sample is representative of the population of interest.

Validation studies must demonstrate clinical utility (validation of instruments that are only intended for research use are not accepted). Studies that only report psychometric properties of a translation of a test are usually not accepted (i.e., clinical utility and construct/criterion validities of the instrument also need to be demonstrated). Articles published in this online-only supplement are abstracted and indexed in the same publications and databases as are articles published in the printed issues of the journal.
