Journal of Sports Sciences – Checklist for "Special Issue" proposals

Proposal preparation

- 1. Determine a relevant theme for the Special Issue
 - a. Discuss the proposal with Special Issue Executive Editor
- 2. Select appropriate submissions/authors/topics
 - a. Open-call: List potential sub-themes
 - b. Close-call: Make contact with potential contributors
 - c. Output from a themed conference or seminar
- 3. Complete the Special Issue Proposal Form

Proposal submission

4. Submit your proposal to the Special Issue Executive Editor

Evaluation and decision

- 5. Await approval from the Special Issue Executive Editor
 - a. The Special Issue Executive Editor, in consultation with the editorial board, review the proposal based on its relevance, scientific merit, originality, and alignment with the journal's objectives
 - b. The decision regarding the acceptance of the proposal is communicated to the Guest Editor(s) in a timely manner (4-6 weeks)

Manuscripts submission and review:

- 6. Collaborate with authors and conduct a pre-review of their papers before submission to the journal
- 7. All submitted manuscripts undergo a rigorous peer-review process (a minimum of two reviewers) to ensure scientific quality
- 8. Receive feedback from peer reviewers
- 9. Make recommendations based on reviewers' feedback, which may include acceptance or suggestions for minor revisions, major revisions, or outright rejection.
 - Engage in discussions with the Special Issue Executive Editor regarding the papers, if necessary
 - b. Provide support to authors in preparing their responses to the reviewers' comments
- 10. Have individual authors resubmit their papers for additional review (if required)
- 11. Make final recommendations based on reviewers' feedback, determining whether minor revisions, major revisions, or rejection are necessary

Publication

- 12. Prepare an editorial to accompany the Special Issue
- 13. Coordinate with the Special Issue Executive Editor and Editorial Assistant to address any outstanding issues, such as the order of papers, front page, etc.
- 14. Once the accepted manuscripts have gone through the review process and any necessary revisions, the Special Issue is finalised and published
